- 2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended and declared ineligible until an approved transfer report is on file.
- 3. Head Coach Bob Cruikshank is reprimanded for allowing this violation to occur.
- 4. The contest in which the ineligible athlete participated shall be forfeited if Peru was victorious and the opposing school shall be notified of this violation.

Pioneer High School – (*Volleyball player participated in tournament series events while being omitted from the sectional entry list*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 3-9.4.

- 1. Athletic Director Mike Johnson and Head Volleyball Coach Rod Nies are reprimanded for allowing this error to occur. It is imperative that the athletic director along with the head coach insure that the entry list for each team entered into an IHSAA tournament series is accurate in every detail.
- 2. Under the provisions of Rule 16-3, the Commissioner may accept an alternative penalty as opposed to disqualifying the student athlete.
- 3. Pioneer High School shall remit \$500.00 to the IHSAA in reference to aforementioned penalty.
- 4. Tournament Director Debb Stevens is commended for her handling of this matter.

River Forest High School – (*Football player participated in multiple contests without an approved transfer report on file*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3.

- 1. The River Forest High School football program is issued a warning.
- 2. The student involved in this violation is declared ineligible until such time an approved transfer report is on file.
- 3. The interscholastic contests in which this ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if River Forest was victorious. The opposing schools shall be made aware of this violation.

Seeger High School – (*Boys' cross country runner participated in a non-school sponsored event without an approved waiver*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 15-1.1a.

- 1. The Seeger High School boys' cross country program is issued a warning.
- The student shall be suspended for next cross country meet on the current Seeger High School schedule

Shakamak High School – (Volleyball player participated in a practice at another school). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 15-1.2c.

1. The Shakamak High School volleyball program is issued a warning.

- 2. It is understood that the student involved in this violation has served a one game suspension issued by the school administration. The IHSAA accepts this suspension as an appropriate measure in this matter.
- 3. The practice session attended by the student shall count as a contest toward the maximum number of contests this student may participate in during the regular season.

Shenandoah High School – (*Volleyball player participated in a match while academically ineligible*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 18-1.

- 1. The Shenandoah High School volleyball program is issued a warning.
- 2. The student involved in this violation is declared ineligible until such time the student may become academically eligible.
- 3. The interscholastic contest in which this ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if Shenandoah was victorious. The opposing school shall be made aware of this violation.

South Central (Union Mills) High School – ((Football player participated in multiple games while academically ineligible). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 18-1.

- 1. The South Central High School football program is issued a warning.
- 2. The student involved in this violation is declared ineligible until such time the student may become academically eligible.
- 3. The interscholastic contests in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if South Central was victorious. The opposing schools shall be made aware of this violation.

Tippecanoe Valley High School – (*Volleyball player participated in six sets in a single day*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 111-4.

- 1. The Tippecanoe Valley High School volleyball program is issued a warning.
- 2. Coach Mallory Eaton is reprimanded for permitting this violation to occur. A lack of attentiveness to the rules is not an acceptable explanation for a rules violation.
- 3. In accordance with rule 3-9 of the IHSAA By-Laws, Bremen High School must be notified that this violation occurred and the match in which the maximum number of sets was exceeded must be forfeited if Tippecanoe Valley was victorious.
- 4. Participation in these six sets shall count as two matches for the student in violation.

Tri High School – (*Two football players participated in multiple contests without an approved transfer report on file*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3.

- 1. The Tri High School football program is issued a warning.
- 2. The students involved in this violation are declared ineligible until such time an approved transfer report is on file.
- 3. The interscholastic contests in which these ineligible athletes participated in shall be forfeited if Tri was victorious. The opposing schools shall be made aware of this violation.
