PENALTIES ASSESSED

Andrean High School – (*Football player participated in multiple contests without an approved transfer report on file*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3.

1. The Andrean High School football program is issued a warning.
2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended and declared ineligible until an approved transfer report is on file.
3. The contests in which the ineligible athlete participated shall be forfeited if Andrean was victorious and the opposing schools shall be notified of this violation.

Carroll (Flora) High School – (*Multiple football players participated in multiple games while academically ineligible*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 18-1.

1. The Carroll High School football program is issued a warning.

2. The students involved in this violation are declared ineligible until such time the students may become academically eligible.
3. The interscholastic contests in which these ineligible athletes participated in shall be forfeited if Carroll was victorious. The opposing schools shall be made aware of this violation.

Carroll (Flora) High School – *(Football player participated in multiple games without an approved transfer report on file)*. Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3.

1. The Carroll High School football program is issued a warning.
2. The student involved in this violation is declared ineligible until such time an approved transfer report is on file.
3. The interscholastic contests in which this ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if Carroll was victorious. The opposing schools shall be made aware of this violation.

Clinton Prairie High School – Sectional Entry List Policy Violation *(Football team withdrew from tournament series after drawing – PROBATION)*

1. The Clinton Prairie High School football program is placed on probation for the 2015-16 season. This probation is a severe type of warning. It is official notice that serious violations have occurred, are a matter of record and future, similar incidents will not be tolerated.
2. As per IHSAA policy, Clinton Prairie shall remit \$200.00 as a financial penalty in this matter.

Covington High School – *(Football player failed to complete mandatory sportsmanship course prior to returning to play after an ejection)*. Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 8-4b.

2. The student involved in this violation is declared ineligible until such time the student completes the mandatory online education course.
3. The contest in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if Covington was victorious. The opposing school shall be notified of this violation.

Crown Point High School – *(Girls' cross country runner participated in multiple meets without an approved transfer report on file)*. Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3.

1. The Crown Point High School girls' cross country program is issued a warning.
2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended and declared ineligible until an approved transfer report is on file.
3. The contests in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be rescored after removing the ineligible athlete's scores and the opposing schools shall be notified of this violation.

Culver Community High School – *(Boys' soccer player participated in multiple contests without an approved transfer report on file)*. Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3.

1. The Culver Community High School boys' soccer program is issued a warning.
2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended and declared ineligible until an approved transfer report is on file.
3. The contests in which the ineligible athlete participated shall be forfeited if Culver Community was victorious and the opposing schools shall be notified of this violation.

Edinburgh High School – *(Football player participated in a contest while academically ineligible)*. Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 18-1.

1. The Edinburgh High School football program is issued a warning.
2. The student involved in this violation is declared ineligible until such time the student may become academically eligible.
3. The interscholastic contest in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if Edinburgh was victorious. The opposing school shall be made aware of this violation.

Gary West Side High School – *(Football player participated in two games without an approved transfer report on file)*. Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3.

1. The Gary West Side High School football program is issued a warning.
2. The student involved in this violation is declared ineligible until such time an approved transfer report is on file.
3. The interscholastic contests in which this ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if Gary West Side was victorious. The opposing schools shall be made aware of this violation.

Indianapolis Broad Ripple High School - (*Three cross country runners participated in several meets without approved foreign exchange student eligibility reports on file*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3.

1. The Indianapolis Broad Ripple High School girls' cross country program is issued a warning.
2. The student athletes involved in this violation shall be suspended and declared ineligible until approved transfer reports are on file.
3. The contests in which the ineligible athletes participated in shall be rescored after removing the ineligible athletes' scores and the opposing schools shall be notified of this violation.

Indianapolis Cathedral High School – (*Junior varsity football player participated in two contests without an approved transfer report on file*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3.

1. The Indianapolis Cathedral High School football program is issued a warning.
2. The student involved in this violation is declared ineligible until such time an approved transfer report is on file.
3. The interscholastic contests in which this ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if Indianapolis Cathedral was victorious. The opposing schools shall be made aware of this violation.

Indianapolis Lutheran High School – Sectional Entry List Policy Violation (*Girls' soccer team withdrew from tournament series after drawing – PROBATION*).

1. The Indianapolis Lutheran High School girls' soccer program is placed on probation for the 2015-16 season. This probation is a severe type of warning. It is official notice that serious violations have occurred, are a matter of record and future, similar incidents will not be tolerated.
2. As per IHSAA policy, Indianapolis Lutheran shall remit \$200.00 as a financial penalty in this matter.

Indianapolis Emmerich Manual High School – (*Football player participated in multiple games while in his ninth semester of high school*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 12-2.

1. The Indianapolis Manual football program is issued a warning.
2. In accordance with Rule 3-9 of the IHSAA By-Laws, the schools against which this ineligible student competed shall be notified of this violation and Manual High School shall forfeit any contests in which they were victorious.

Indianapolis Metropolitan High School – Sectional Entry List Policy Violation (*Boys' soccer team withdrew from tournament series after drawing – PROBATION*).

1. The Indianapolis Metropolitan boys' soccer program is placed on probation for the 2015-16 season. This probation is a severe type of warning. It is official notice that serious violations have occurred, are a matter of record and future, similar incidents will not be tolerated.
2. As per IHSAA policy, Indianapolis Metropolitan High School shall remit \$200.00 as a financial penalty in this matter.

Indianapolis Northwest High School – (*Football player participated in a game without an approved transfer report on file*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3.

1. The Indianapolis Northwest High School football program is issued a warning.
2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended and declared ineligible until an approved transfer report is on file.
3. The contest in which the ineligible athlete participated shall be forfeited if Indianapolis Northwest was victorious and the opposing schools shall be notified of this violation.

Madison High School – (*Football player participated in six quarters in a single football week*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 54-3.2.

1. The Madison Consolidated High School football program is issued a warning.
2. Head Coach Patric Morrison reprimanded for allowing this violation to occur.

3. All quarters played shall count against the maximum number of quarters allowed for the student athletes involved in this violation.
4. In accordance with Rule 3-9, Floyd Central High School shall be notified of this violation and if Madison was victorious, the game shall be forfeited.

Madison-Grant High School – (*Girls' cross country runner participated in a non-school sponsored event without an approved waiver*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 15-1.1a.

1. The Madison-Grant High School girls' cross country program is issued a warning.
2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended for the next meet on the Madison-Grant girls' cross country schedule.

Marion High School – (*Football player participated in multiple contests in violation of the age rule*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 4.1.

1. The Marion High School football program is issued a warning.
2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended and declared ineligible for further competition.
3. In accordance with Rule 3-9, the contests in which the ineligible athlete participated shall be forfeited if Marion was victorious. The participating schools involved with this violation shall be notified.

Peru High School – (*Two boys' cross country runners participated in multiple meets without approved transfer reports on file*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3.

1. The Peru High School volleyball program is issued a warning.
2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended and declared ineligible until an approved transfer report is on file.
3. Head Coach Bob Cruikshank is reprimanded for allowing this violation to occur.
4. The contest in which the ineligible athlete participated shall be forfeited if Peru was victorious and the opposing school shall be notified of this violation.

Pioneer High School – (*Volleyball player participated in tournament series events while being omitted from the sectional entry list*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 3-9.4.

1. Athletic Director Mike Johnson and Head Volleyball Coach Rod Nies are reprimanded for allowing this error to occur. It is imperative that the athletic director along with the head coach insure that the entry list for each team entered into an IHSAA tournament series is accurate in every detail.
2. Under the provisions of Rule 16-3, the Commissioner may accept an alternative penalty as opposed to disqualifying the student athlete.
3. Pioneer High School shall remit \$500.00 to the IHSAA in reference to aforementioned penalty.
4. Tournament Director Debb Stevens is commended for her handling of this matter.

River Forest High School – (*Football player participated in multiple contests without an approved transfer report on file*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3.

1. The River Forest High School football program is issued a warning.
2. The student involved in this violation is declared ineligible until such time an approved transfer report is on file.
3. The interscholastic contests in which this ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if River Forest was victorious. The opposing schools shall be made aware of this violation.

Seeger High School – (*Boys' cross country runner participated in a non-school sponsored event without an approved waiver*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 15-1.1a.

1. The Seeger High School boys' cross country program is issued a warning.
2. The student shall be suspended for next cross country meet on the current Seeger High School schedule

Shakamak High School – (*Volleyball player participated in a practice at another school*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 15-1.2c.

1. The Shakamak High School volleyball program is issued a warning.

2. It is understood that the student involved in this violation has served a one game suspension issued by the school administration. The IHSAA accepts this suspension as an appropriate measure in this matter.
3. The practice session attended by the student shall count as a contest toward the maximum number of contests this student may participate in during the regular season.

Shenandoah High School – (*Volleyball player participated in a match while academically ineligible*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 18-1.

1. The Shenandoah High School volleyball program is issued a warning.
2. The student involved in this violation is declared ineligible until such time the student may become academically eligible.
3. The interscholastic contest in which this ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if Shenandoah was victorious. The opposing school shall be made aware of this violation.

South Central (Union Mills) High School – (*Football player participated in multiple games while academically ineligible*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 18-1.

1. The South Central High School football program is issued a warning.
2. The student involved in this violation is declared ineligible until such time the student may become academically eligible.
3. The interscholastic contests in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if South Central was victorious. The opposing schools shall be made aware of this violation.

Tippecanoe Valley High School – (*Volleyball player participated in six sets in a single day*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 111-4.

1. The Tippecanoe Valley High School volleyball program is issued a warning.
2. Coach Mallory Eaton is reprimanded for permitting this violation to occur. A lack of attentiveness to the rules is not an acceptable explanation for a rules violation.
3. In accordance with rule 3-9 of the IHSAA By-Laws, Bremen High School must be notified that this violation occurred and the match in which the maximum number of sets was exceeded must be forfeited if Tippecanoe Valley was victorious.
4. Participation in these six sets shall count as two matches for the student in violation.

Tri High School – (*Two football players participated in multiple contests without an approved transfer report on file*). Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3.

1. The Tri High School football program is issued a warning.
2. The students involved in this violation are declared ineligible until such time an approved transfer report is on file.
3. The interscholastic contests in which these ineligible athletes participated in shall be forfeited if Tri was victorious. The opposing schools shall be made aware of this violation.
